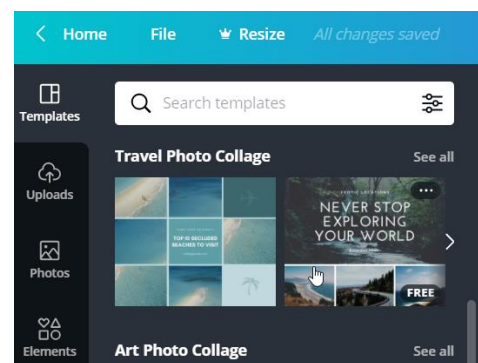
Assignment

Create a photo collage under the topic **“Reduce plastic waste”**.

1. In Canva, choose **“photo collage”** from the menu. Or use the search bar on the top.

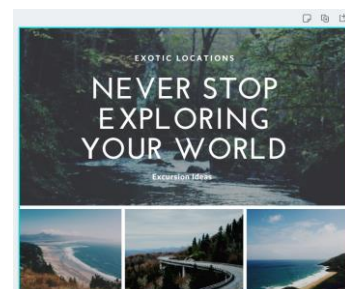


2. Choose the template from the given list. You may only use a free template (those with the **“FREE”**; with no **“PRO”**, **“Premium”**, or the \$ symbol). For mobile users, the Template menu is at the bottom within the **“Menu”**.



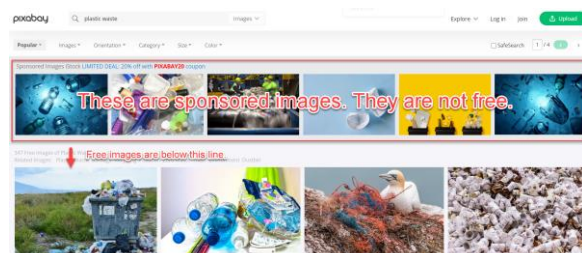
3. Be familiar with the template you chose and recognize the size of photos and elements you need.

For this template, you need one big photo, three small photos, and a few lines of heading text. →



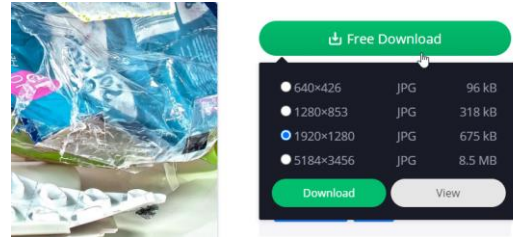
4. Search **Pixabay** (pixabay.com) for photos you need.

Hint: Use the keyword **“plastic waste”**



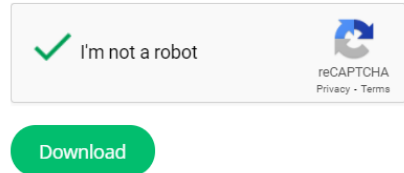
Collect all the photos you need. They are not copyrighted.

To save a picture from Pixabay, with the selected photo, click **“Free Download”**, choose the preferred dimensions, and click **“Download”**. You may right click on the photo and **“Save as ...”**.

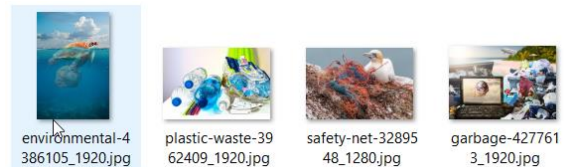


Sometimes, the **“Capcha”** is required if you did not sign in. But sign in is not required anyway. You can just verify if you are not a robot 😊 and proceed with the download.

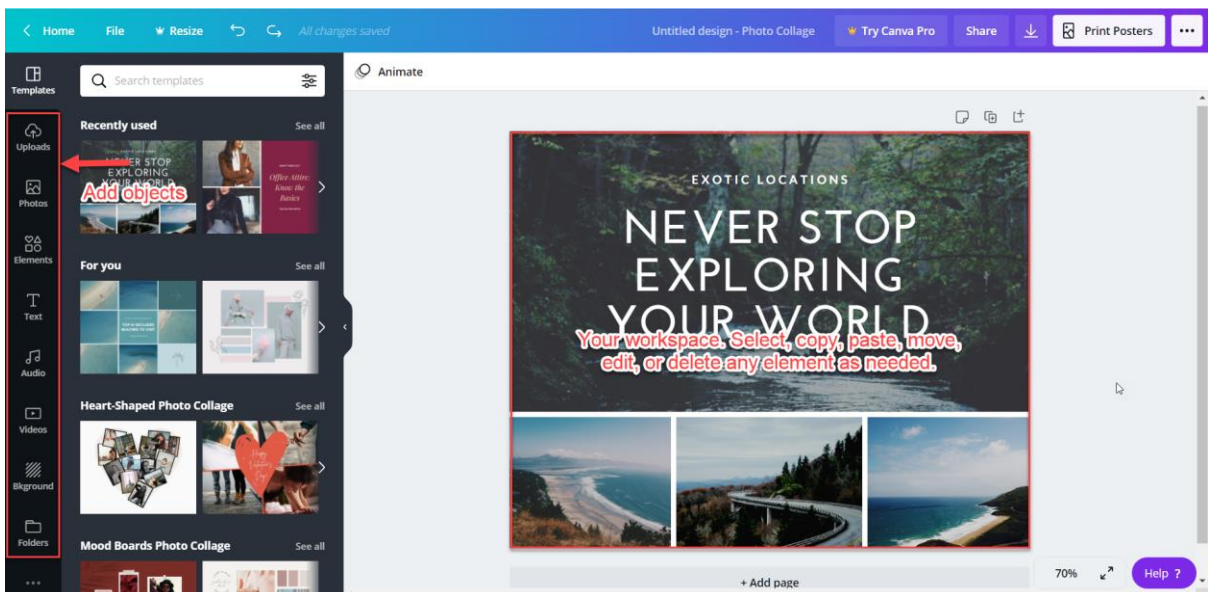
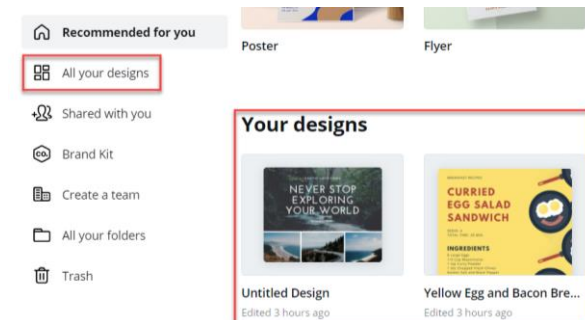

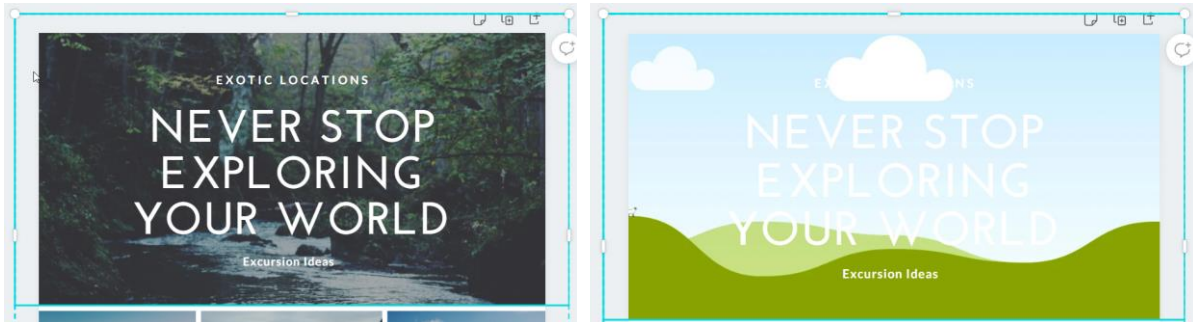
5. Collect all the images in a local folder and go back to Canva.



Your project is saved automatically. If you closed the browser, you can browse your files from the **“Your designs”** menu. For mobile users, the **“Design”** menu is at the bottom.

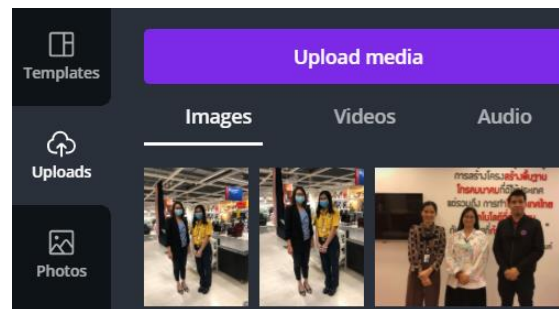


To delete an existing photo, select it and hit the “**Delete**” button on your keyboard. For mobile users, tap the image and choose to delete (a recycle bin icon).

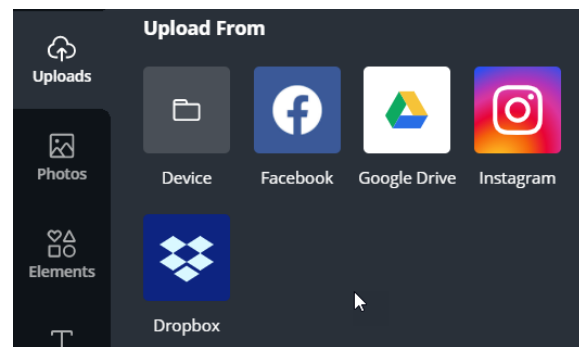


The background image shows that there should be a photo in that block but now it is empty.

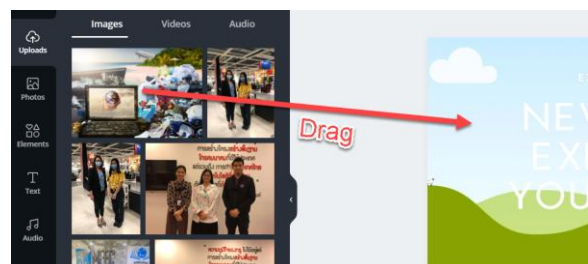
To upload a new photo, go to “**Uploads**”. From this page you can click “**Upload media**” to upload a new file or select your recently uploaded file. For mobile users, tap the + button (lower-right) and select the Uploads menu.

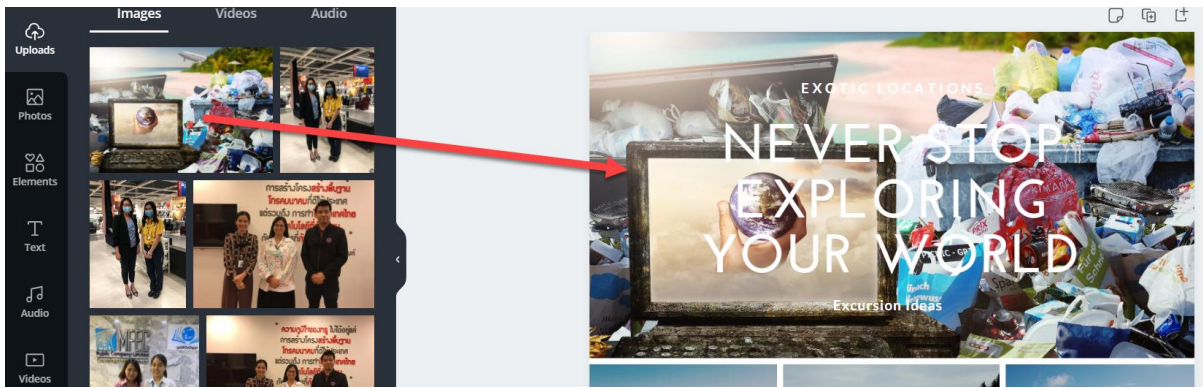


If you choose to upload a new file, you will have an option to upload from your local drive (Device), or you can upload from your cloud drive (e.g., Google Drive and Dropbox).

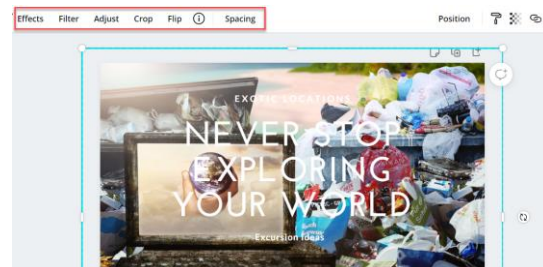


When the upload finished, the photo will appear in the Uploads menu. You can drag a photo to the empty block to add it. For mobile users, tap the empty image block, choose Replace, and browse the uploads menu.



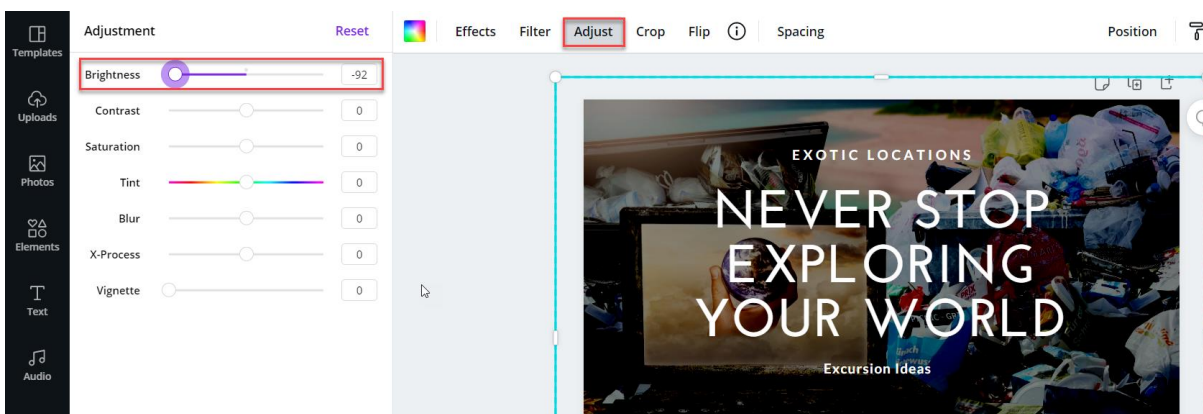


To modify the added image, select it and the toolbar will appear. You can apply the effect, filter, or make adjustment (e.g., brightness and contrast). You can also crop, flip, or rotate the image.

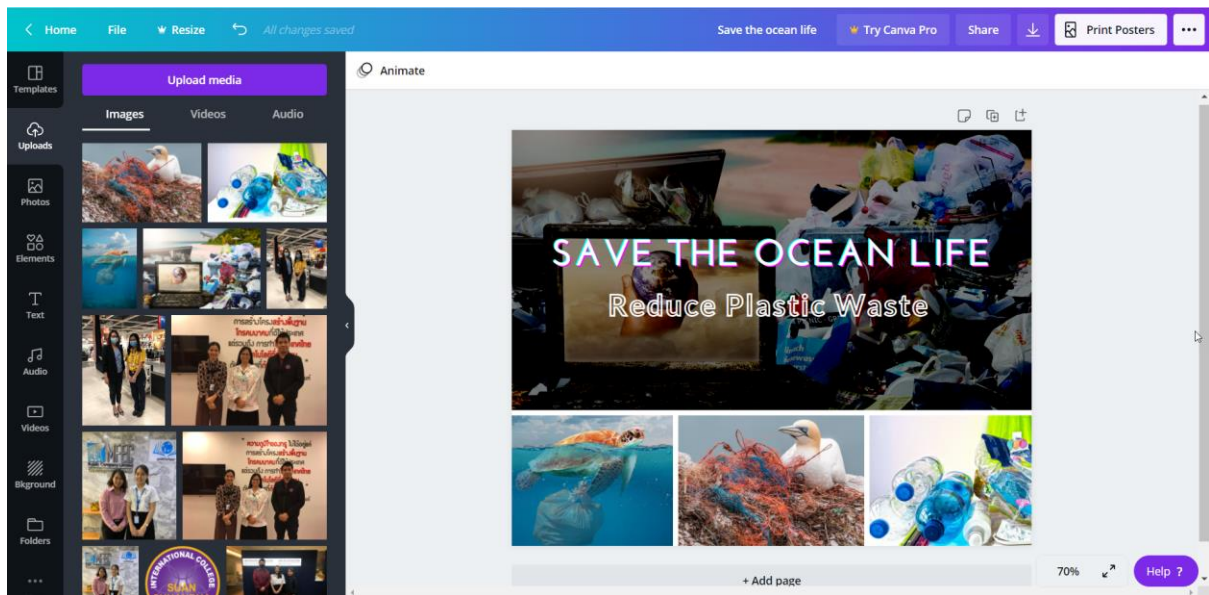


If there are multiple layers, you can change the image positions (decide which photo appears on the top). You can also add a hyperlink (which will open the web page when clicked; only applicable with digital media).

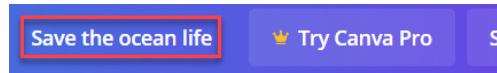
For this image, you notice that background image and foreground text are not contrast. Viewers can hardly read the text. Therefore, we should lower the image brightness.



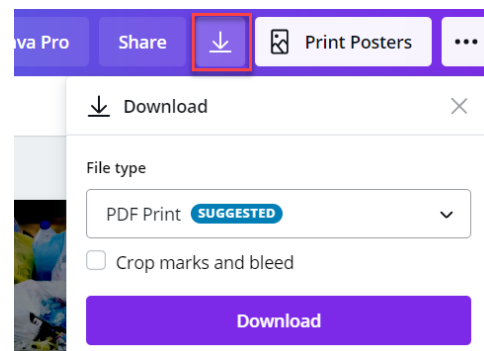
Add more elements as needed, such as additional text boxes and logos, and finalize the project. Note that you can only use free stuffs.



This is the file name. It is automatically chosen for the first time but can be edited.



Your file is saved automatically in your Canva account. To download the finished project, click the download button, choose the file type (JPG, PNG, or PDF for a photo) and click “**Download**”. Mobile users may need to save the finished work somewhere else where you can reach it (e.g., SD card or email).



If it suggests you apply a free trial, choose **NO**.
