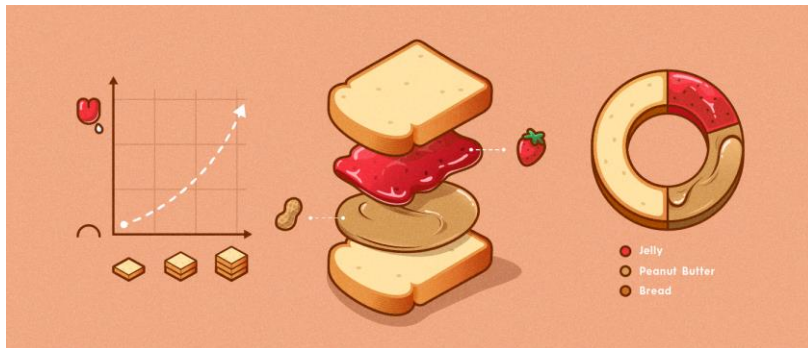

Infographics are graphic visual representations of information, data, or knowledge intended to present information quickly and clearly.



Human recognizes patterns and trends by using visual inspection quicker than using detailed reading.

❖ Just an English lesson before we start ❖

When you write the word “**infographics**”

- There is no space
- Always add the “s” (*use a plural form*) if “**graphics**” is a subjective noun (*noun as a subject*).

Example: computer graphics, infographics

- If it is an appositive noun (*nouns as a modifier*), you may use either singular or plural form.

Example: infographic(s) work, graphic(s) designer

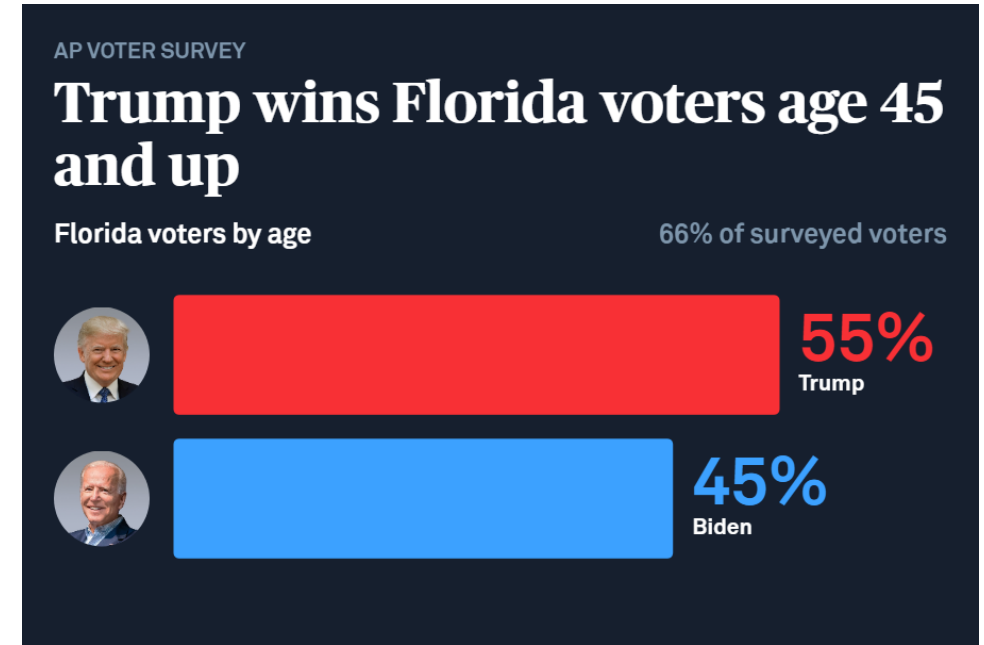

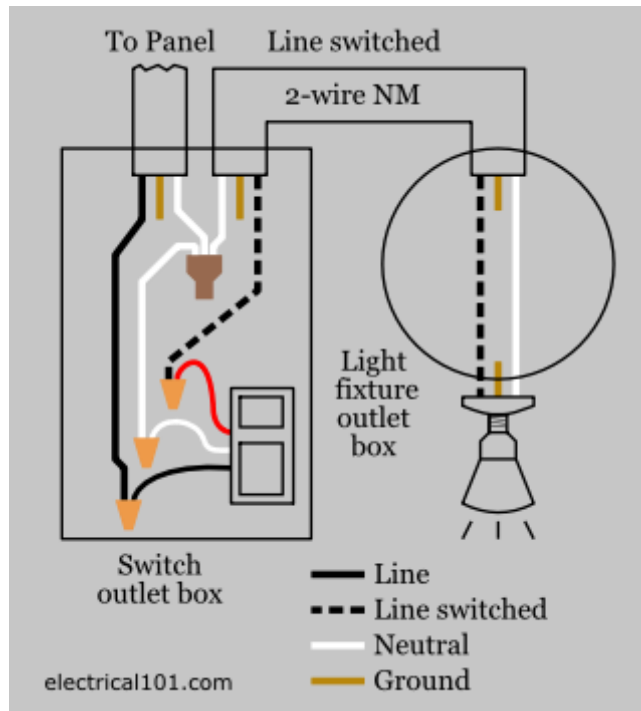

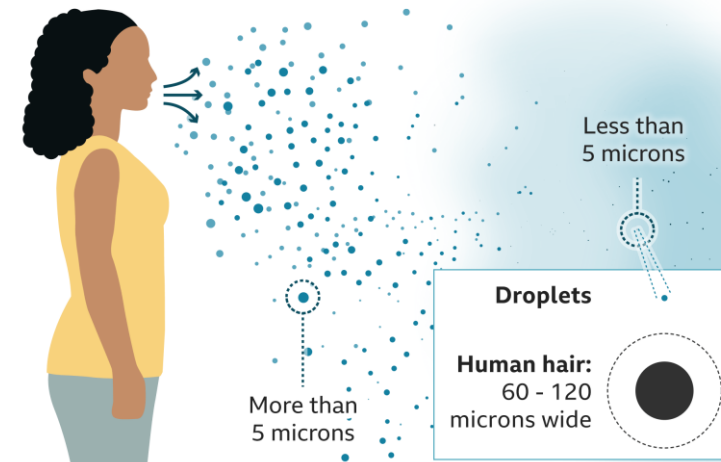
The difference between droplet and airborne transmission

Coughs and sneezes can spread droplets of saliva and mucus

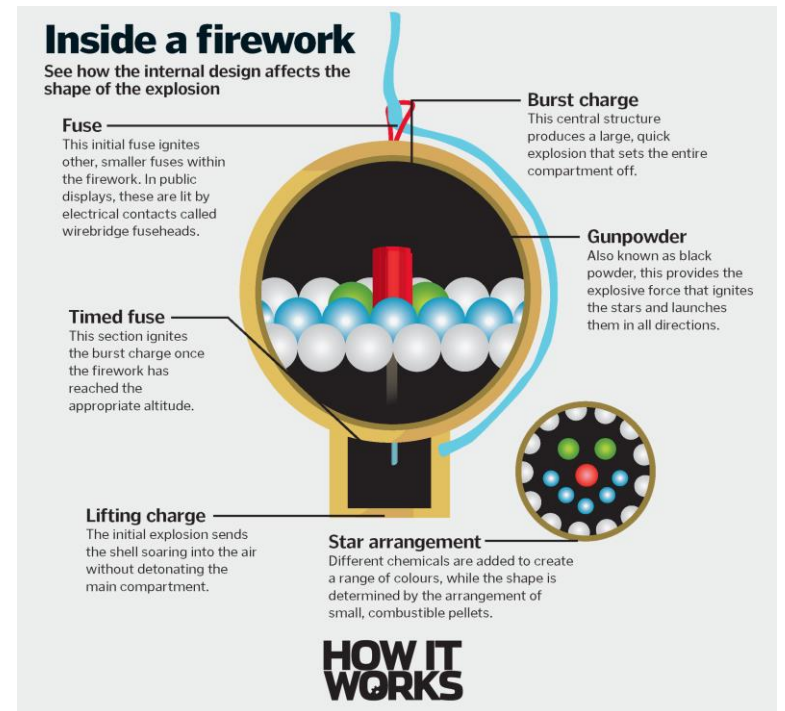
Airborne transmission

Tiny particles, possibly produced by talking, are suspended in the air for longer and travel further

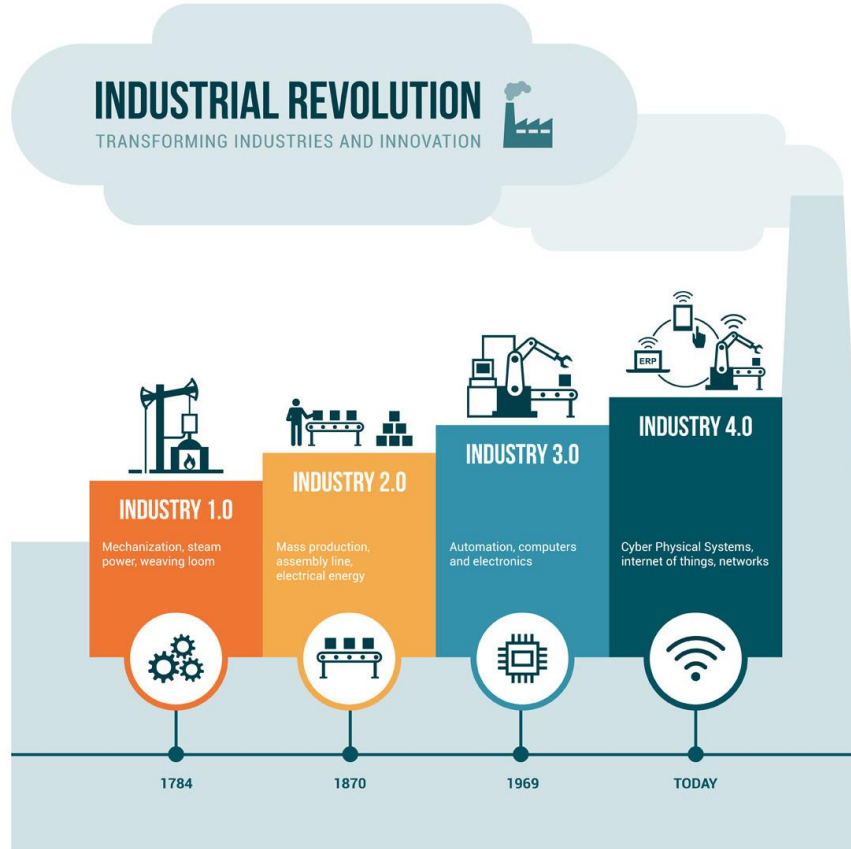

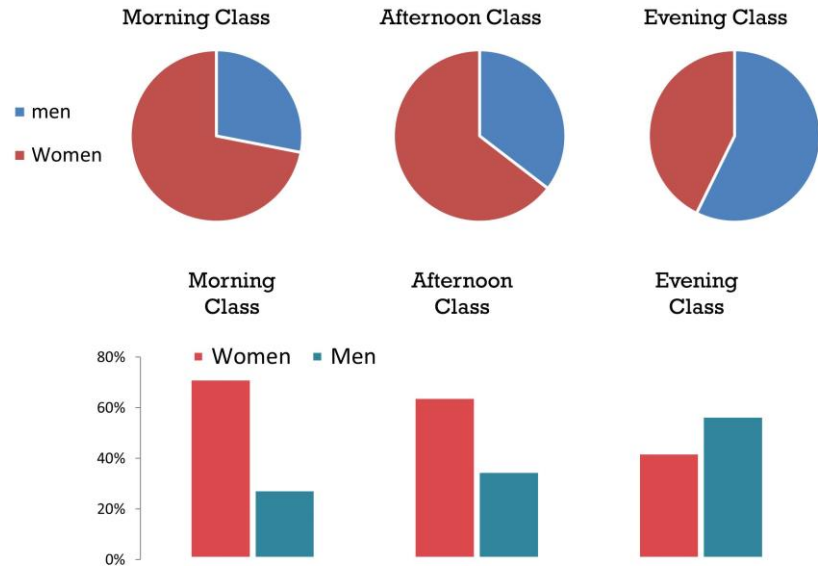

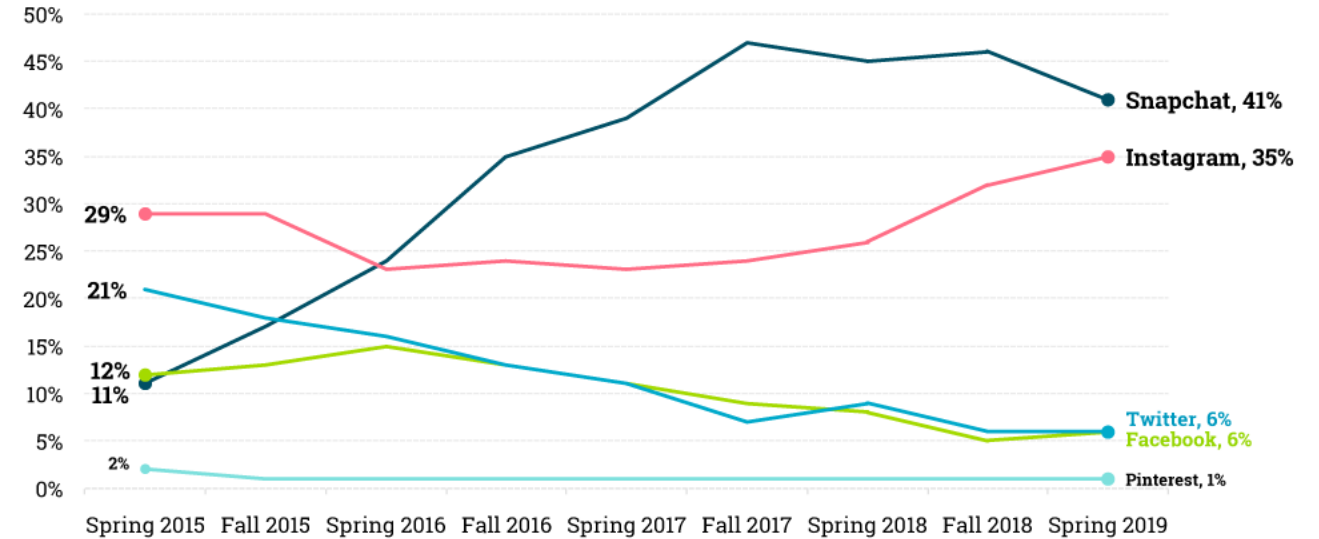

marketing charts



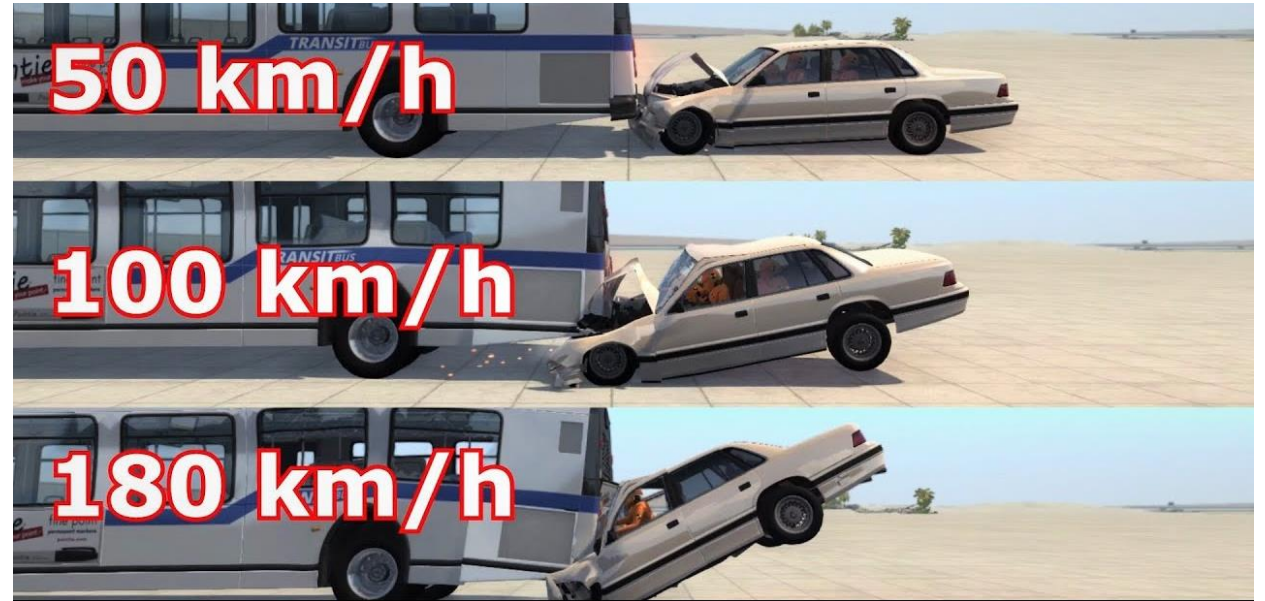
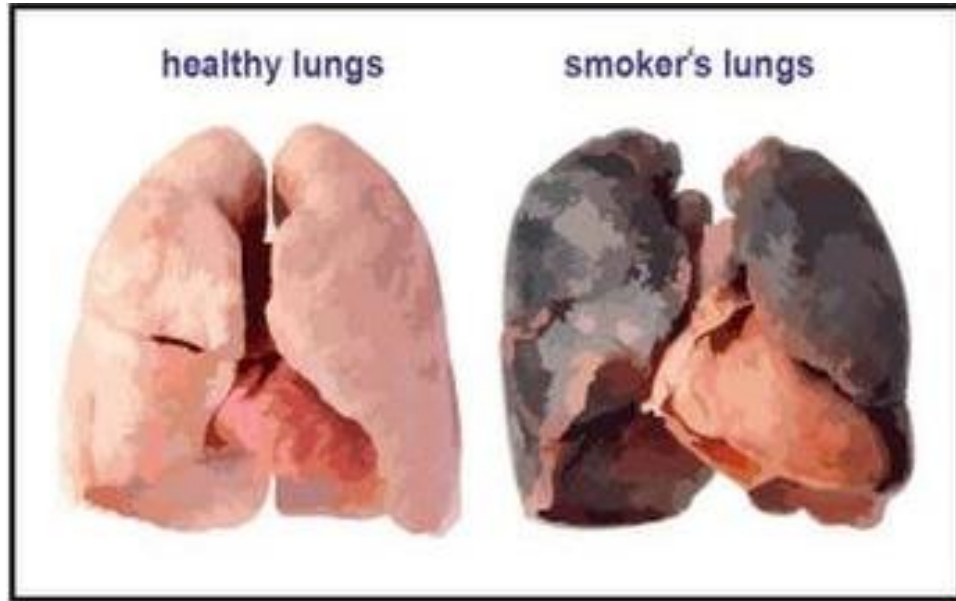

Light energy emitted by the sun warms the earth's surface, which reflects the energy as heat that warms the atmosphere. Much of the heat is captured by greenhouse gas molecules such as water, carbon dioxide, and methane.

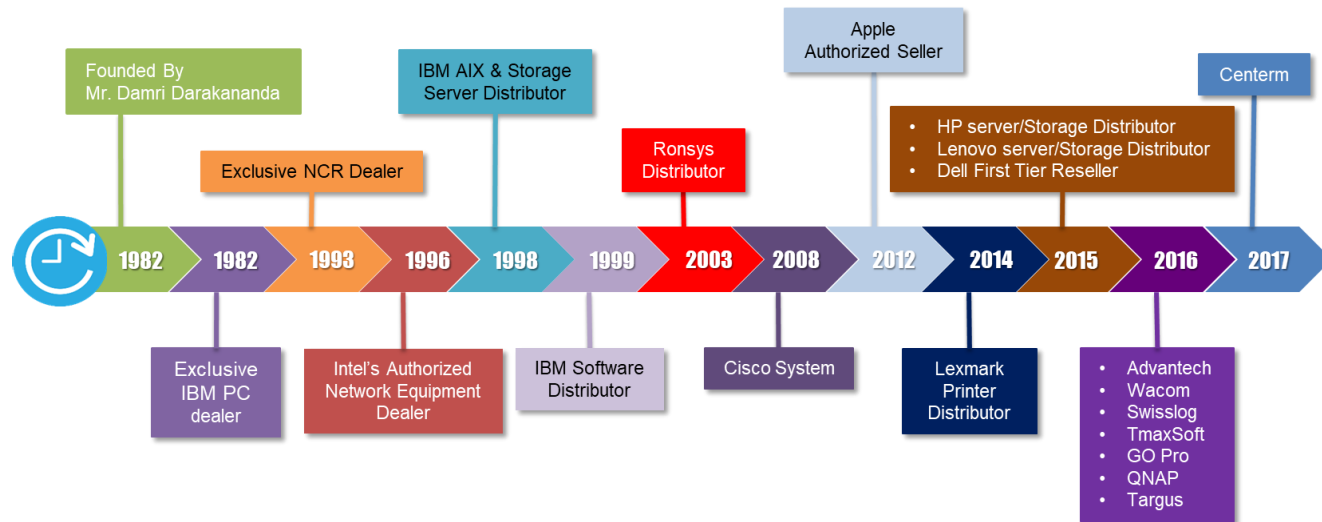


RGB Inside the Camera



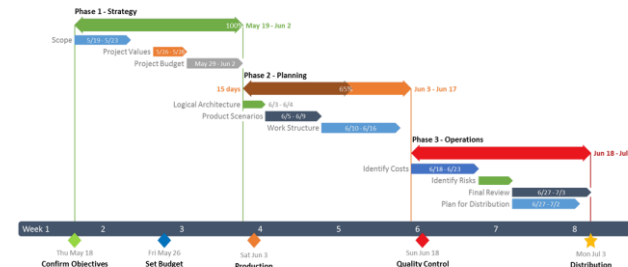
Often used in science and manufacturing to display components inside.

5. Timeline/Roadmap

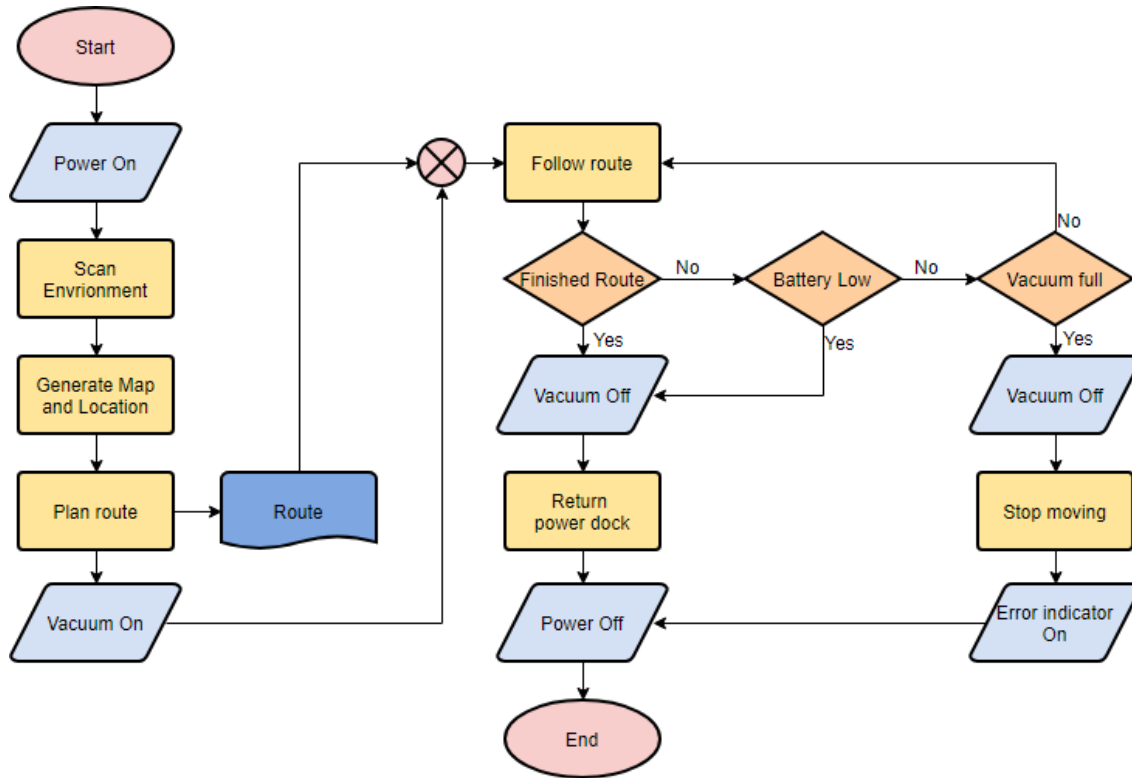







Tell the history of something by using lines, such as people, corporate, and location. Can also be used to inform the roadmap or process (e.g., thesis, recruitment, and business plan).

Technique: Use the distance of each point to tell the time interval.



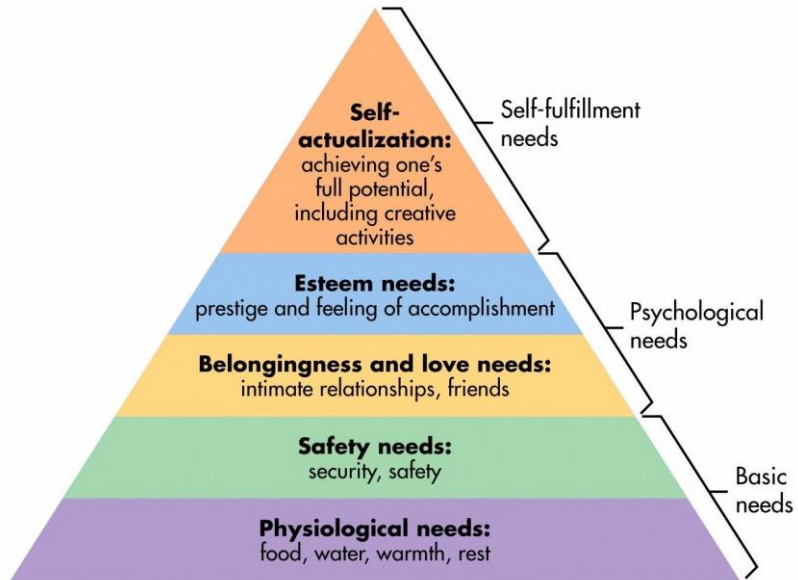
6. Flowchart



Flow Chart Symbol	Meaning	Explanation
	Start and end	The symbol denoting the beginning and end of the flow chart.
	Step	This symbol shows that the user performs a task. (Note: In many flow charts steps and actions are interchangeable.)
	Decision	This symbol represents a point where a decision is made.
	Action	This symbol means that the user performs an action. (Note: In many flow charts steps and actions are interchangeable.)
	Flow line	A line that connects the various symbols in an ordered way.

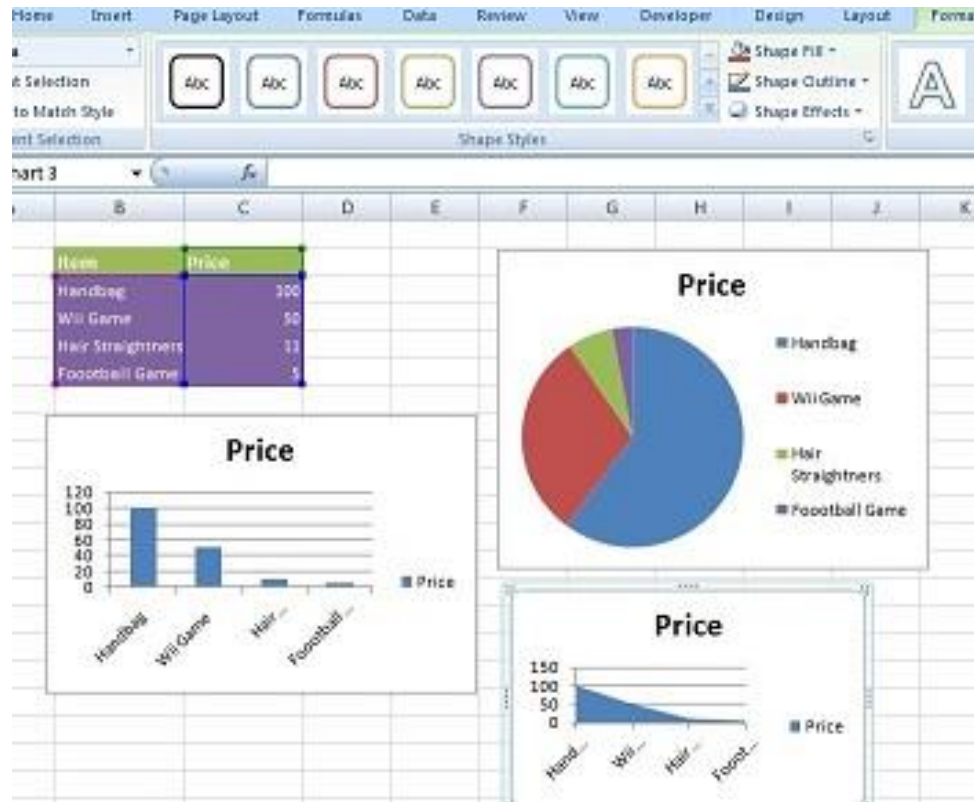
A flowchart consists of steps, actions, and decisions. It is useful, **and necessary**, in computer programming.

7. Hierarchy



Display levels of importance, ranks, and difficulties.
Also used in organization charts.

8. Chart & Graph



- Created from numerical data.
- Used to visualize the data.
- Commonly used in business, research, and statistics.

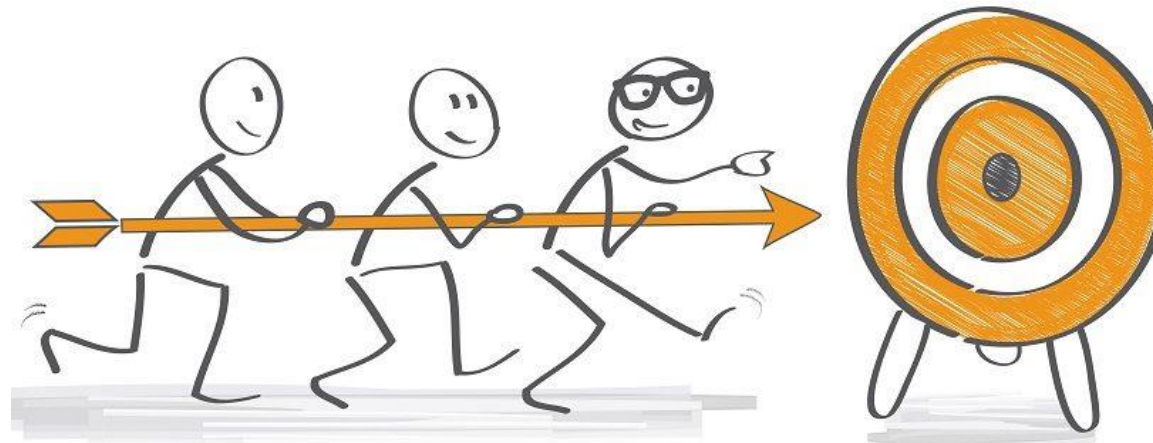


Let's get started

1. Short brief

- What is the topic?
- What are infographics for? Children, adults, or some specific people.
- What are the objectives (*see previous slides*)?

Is that for alerting people or just give information, for instance?



2. Get useful information



Interesting – Present newly updated information, something that is trendy.

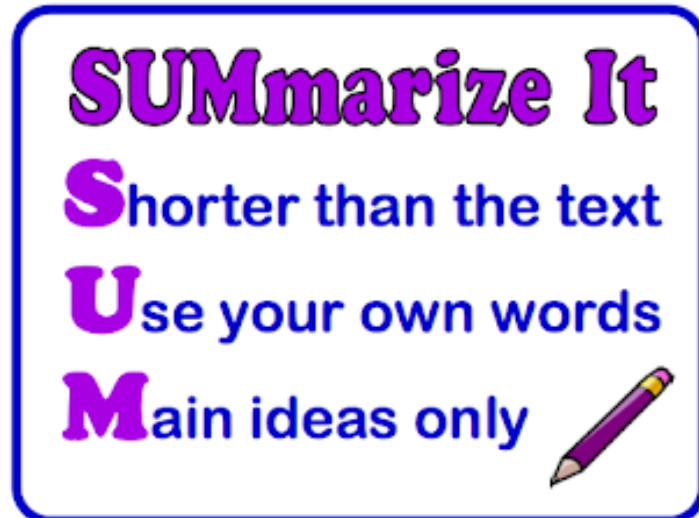
Insightful – Present what people want to know, something that is not often revealed to the public, or something that will save people time for searching themselves.



Reliable – Get information from reliable sources. Always give credit or identify sources.

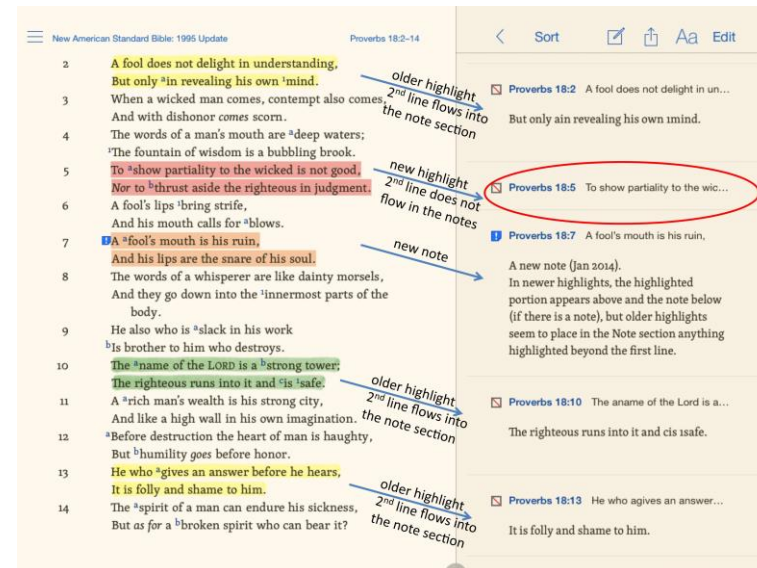
3. Make a conclusive detail

- Infographics are supposed to be short and take little time to remember and understand.
- Detailed information or the whole text needs to be summarized.
- Present only highlights. Discard all useless lengthy details.

6. Start designing

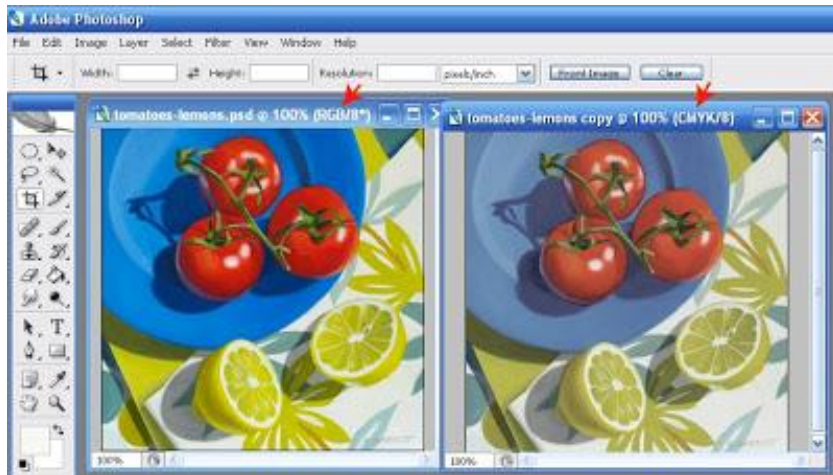


There are several tools that provide infographic templates, such as Canva and PowerPoint. Common tools such as Photoshop and Illustrator are for the professionals.
