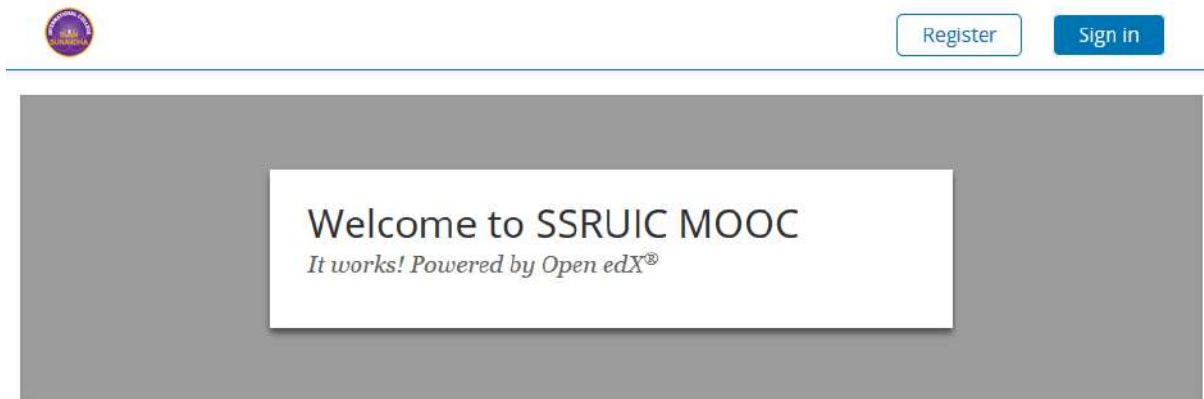

How to watch lesson videos?

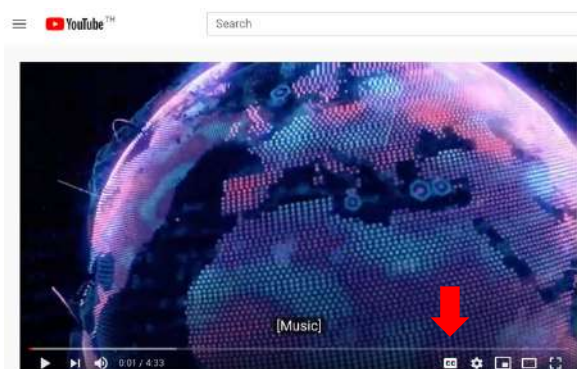

How to use subtitles?

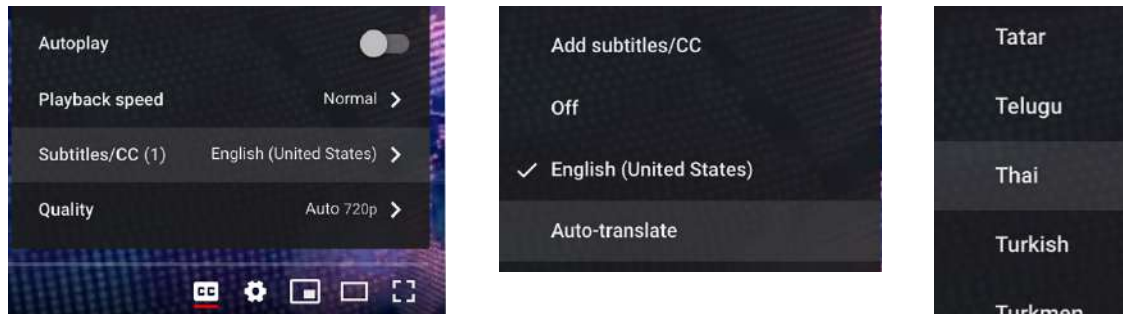
Subtitles are the most useful features here, especially for students who are not really good at English. There are several methods to use subtitles:

1. As you see from the picture above, subtitles are showing on the right. You can click any line to skip the video to that part. Click on the " icon (bottom-right of the video) to close the side subtitle block.
2. To have subtitles displayed at the bottom of the video, click the "CC" button.
3. If you watch the lesson video on YouTube, you can enable or disable subtitles there by clicking on the Subtitle icon "CC".



How to translate subtitles?

Auto-translation is available on YouTube. You must watch the video on YouTube and have subtitles enabled first (see the instruction above). Next, click the settings (**gear/cog**) button. Select the current language, choose **Auto-translate**, and pick any language you want.



Note that if you enabled the subtitles on YouTube, they will show up on all websites that have embedded YouTube videos including this website.
