
How to register for the SSRUIC002 self-learning course?

1. Check your email (@ssru)




Click "Finish Your Registration".


3. Check your email and click the confirmation link.



You will be brought to your dash board and the SSRUIC002 course should be accessible.




Click "View Course" to get access to the course content.

How to get back to this site?


Go to http://edx.ssruic.ssru.ac.th




On the "Courses" tab, click "View Course" under the corresponding course.

How to watch lesson videos?

Most of the materials in this online course are lesson videos. If you are at the content page consisting of a video, you can play the video by clicking on the Play button. Or you can click the YouTube icon to watch that video on YouTube (to use YouTube features such as subtitles, playlists, or watch later).

How to use subtitles?


Subtitles are the most useful features here, especially for students who are not really good at English. There are several methods to use subtitles:

- 1. As you see from the picture above, subtitles are showing on the right. You can click any line to skip the video to that part. Click on the "icon (bottom-right of the video) to close the side subtitle block.
- 2. To have subtitles displayed at the bottom of the video, click the "CC" button.
- 3. If you watch the lesson video on YouTube, you can enable or disable subtitles there by clicking on the Subtitle icon "CC".



How to translate subtitles?

Auto-translation is available on YouTube. You must watch the video on YouTube and have subtitles enabled first (see the instruction above). Next, click the settings (gear/cog) button. Select the current language, choose Auto-translate, and pick any language you want.









Note that if you enabled the subtitles on YouTube, they will show up on all websites that have embedded YouTube videos including this website.




